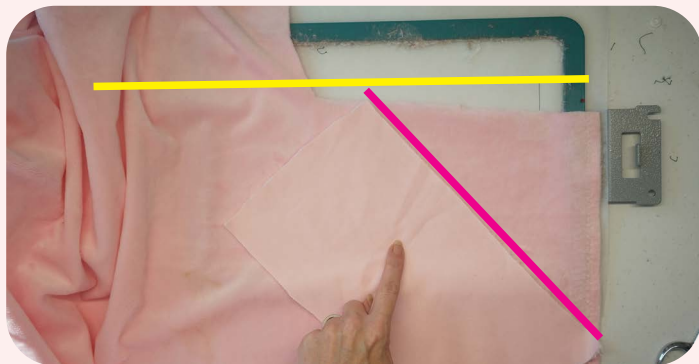
LOAD THE FOOTBALL PART
1 FILE



STITCH THE DIE LINE ON A
NEW PIECE OF MEDIUM TEAR AWAY
STABILIZER.



IF USING COTTON WOVEN
FABRICS CUT FOUR PIECES OF
FABRIC ON THE BIAS. THIS MEANS
CUTTING THE FABRIC AT A 45
DEGREE DIAGONAL ANGLE TO THE
GRAIN. PIECES OF FABRIC SHOULD
BE GENEROUS

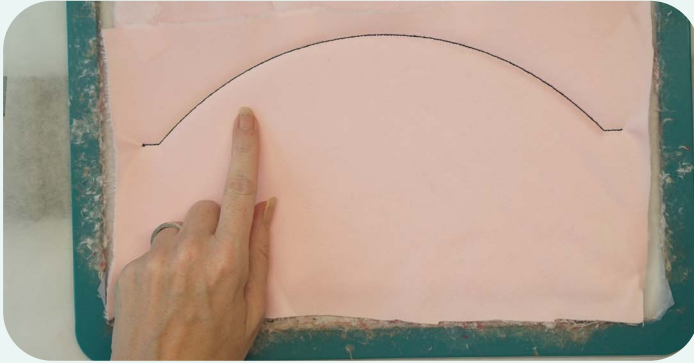


IF USING MINKY OR FLEECE,
WHICH HAS STRETCH SIDE TO SIDE,
MAKE SURE TO CUT THE FABRIC
WITH THE STRETCH MATCHING THE
YELLOW LINE IN THE PHOTO. THE
PINK LINE INDICATES THE BIAS 45
DEGREE CUT FOR COTTON FABRICS
WITH NO STRETCH

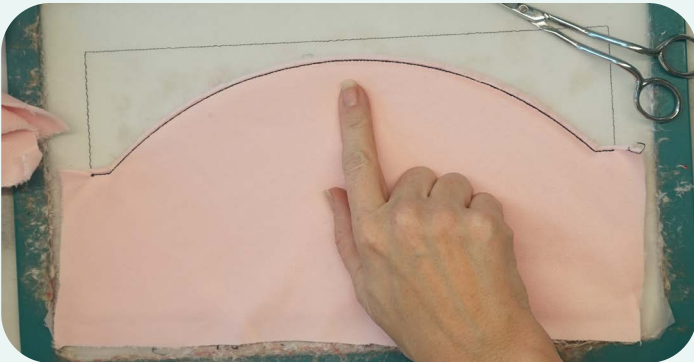


PLACE TWO PIECES OF
FABRIC OVER THE DIE LINE RIGHT
SIDES TOGETHER AND TAPE IN
PLACE

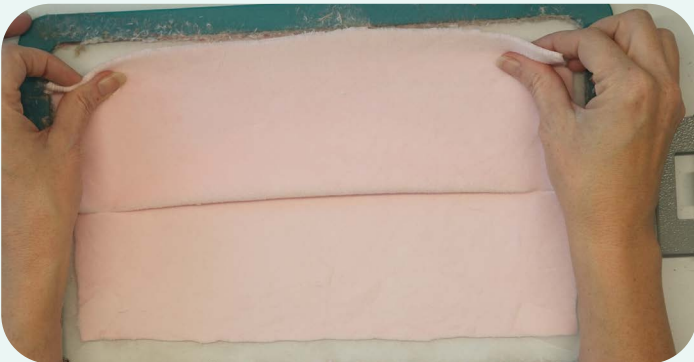
STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINE.



TRIM THE FABRIC CLOSE TO THE TACK DOWN LINE AS SHOWN.



SPRAY SOME TEMPORARY SPRAY ADHESIVE ON THE STABILIZER.

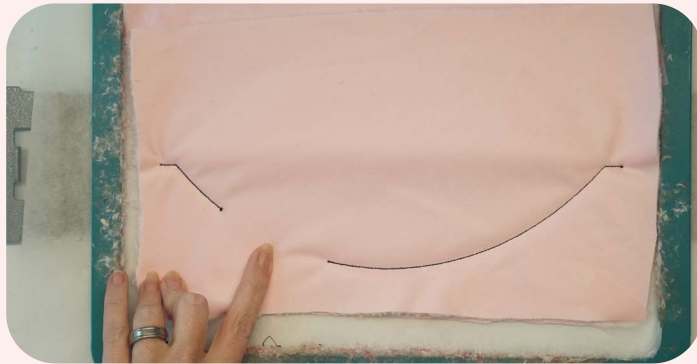


UNFOLD THE TOP LAYER OF FABRIC LIKE A BOOK AND SMOOTH IT TO THE STABILIZER.



PLACE A THIRD PIECE OF FABRIC OVER THE DIE LINE RIGHT SIDE DOWN.

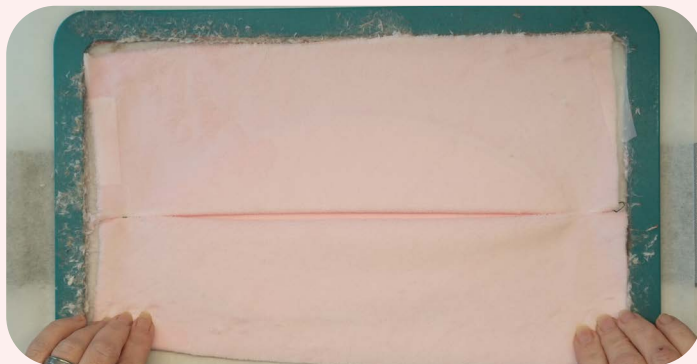
STITCH THE NEXT TACK
DOWN LINE.



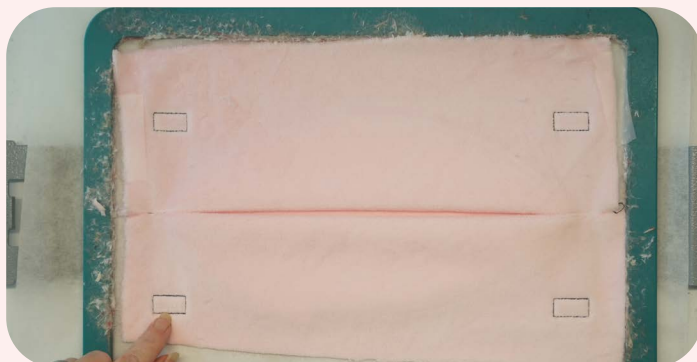
TRIM THE FABRIC CLOSE TO
THE TACK DOWN LINE AS SHOWN.
LEAVE A TAB OF FABRIC AT THE GAP
IN THE STITCHING



SPRAY SOME TEMPORARY
SPRAY ADHESIVE ON THE
STABILIZER.



UNFOLD THE NEW TOP
LAYER OF FABRIC LIKE A BOOK AND
SMOOTH IT TO THE STABILIZER.



STITCH THE ALIGNMENT
RECTANGLES. THERE IS ONE LAST
COLOR STEP TO THIS HOOPING BUT
DO NOT STITCH IT. ITS PLACED TO
PREVENT YOUR MACHINE FROM
RETURNING TO CENTER RUNNING
OVER THE BULK.

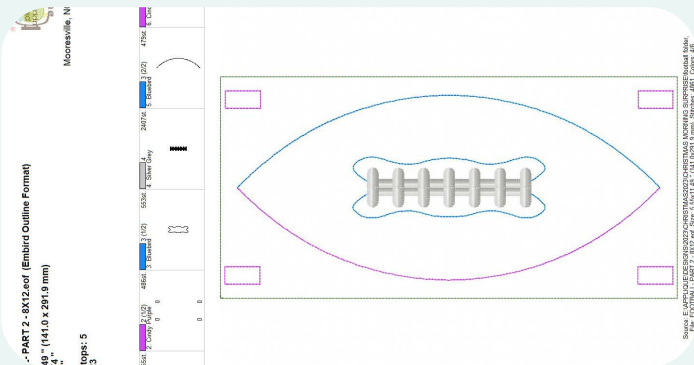

GENTLY REMOVE THE
PANEL FROM THE STABILIZER.



TRY TO RETAIN THE CENTER
FOOTBALL SHAPE ON THE REVERSE
SIDE



LOAD PART 2 OF THE
FOOTBALL



STITCH THE DIE LINE ON A
NEW PIECE OF MEDIUM TEAR AWAY
STABILIZER.



SPRAY SOME TEMPORARY
SPRAY ADHESIVE ON THE
STABILIZER.

PLACE THE FOURTH PIECE OF FABRIC RIGHT SIDE UP AND TAPE IN PLACE.



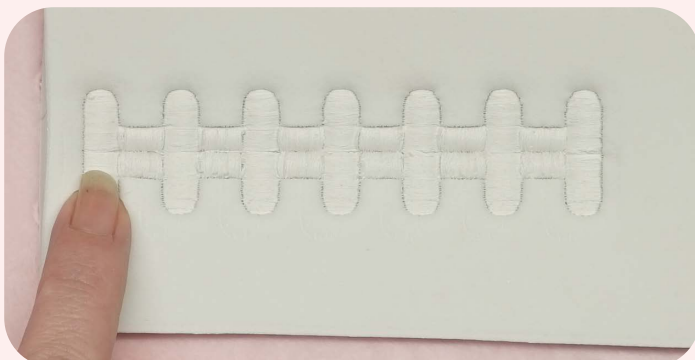
STITCH THE 4 ALIGNMENT RECTANGLES



STITCH THE OUTLINE AROUND THE LACES.



OPTIONAL: PLACE A PIECE OF WHITE CRAFT FOAM OVER THE NEW OUTLINE. I ONLY HAD MM THICK CRAFT FOAM, BUT 2MM-3MM WOULD BE BETTER I BELIEVE. THIS WILL RAISE UP YOUR STITCHES TO LOOK 3 DIMENSIONAL



STITCH THE LACES. IT WILL STITCH DIRECTLY INTO THE FOAM CUTTING IT OUT AS IT STITCHES.

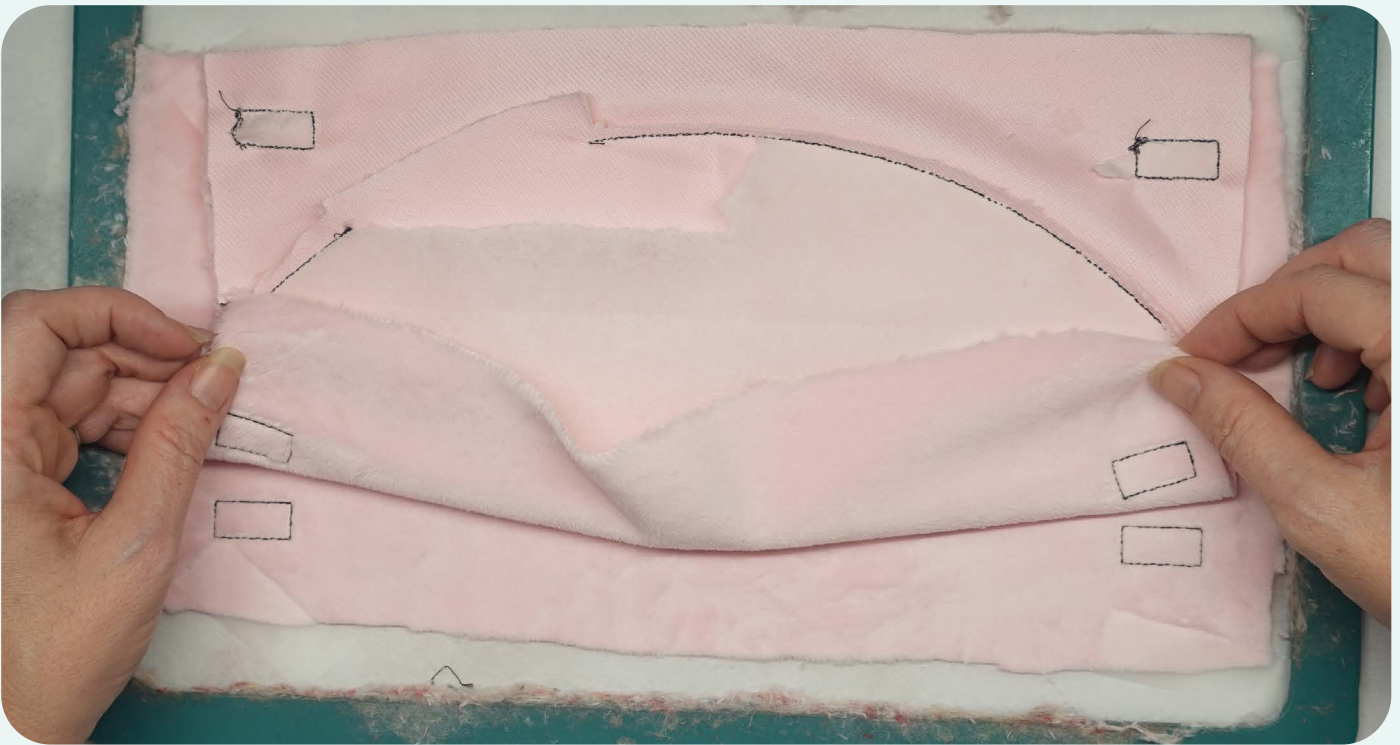

GENTLY PEEL AWAY THE FOAM AROUND THE PERIMETER. YOU CAN USE FINE TIP SCISSORS TO RELEASE ANY STUBBORN AREAS.



NOW WE NEED THE PANEL WE MADE IN PART 1



PLACE IT RIGHT SIDE DOWN OVER THE CURRENT HOOPING. YOU CAN TRIM THE FABRIC AWAY FROM THE STABILIZER TO EXPOSE MORE AREA FOR TAPING IT IN PLACE.

ONCE ALIGNED TAPE IT IN PLACE AS WELL. ALSO TAPE THE SIDES.



FLIP THE FLAPS OVER TO THIS SIDE AND TAPE IN PLACE.



STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINE.

FLIP THE FLAPS OVER
TO THE OTHER SIDE AND TAPE IN
PLACE.



STITCH THE OTHER HALF
OF THE TACK DOWN. THERE IS ONE
LAST COLOR STEP TO THIS HOOPING
BUT DO NOT STITCH IT. ITS PLACED
TO PREVENT YOUR MACHINE FROM
RETURNING TO CENTER RUNNING
OVER THE BULK.



REMOVE THE FOOTBALL
FROM THE HOOP. REMOVE ALL
OF THE STABILIZER ON THE
BACKSIDE.



TRIMA ROUND THE
FOOTBALL 1/4" TO 1/2" FROM THE
TACK DOWN LINE. CAREFUL NOT TO
CUT THE BODY OF THE FOOTBALL.
MAKE SURE THE "POINTS" WHERE
THE FABRIC INTERSECTS ISN'T
CAUGHT IN THE STITCHING. IF IT IS,
CLIP TO RELEASE.



TURN RIGHT SIDE OUT

STUFF THE FOOTBALL TO YOUR LIKING. I RECOMMEND FIRMLY STUFFING IF YOU USED COTTON WOVEN FABRIC.



USE NEEDLE AND THREAD TO LADDER STITCH THE OPENING SHUT. ALL DONE!
