LOAD THE MINI MOUSE FILE



STITCH THE PLACEMENT LINES ON A NEW PIECE OF MEDIUM TEAR AWAY STABILIZER



CUT TWO PIECES OF FABRIC TO COVER THE PLACEMENT LINES.



COVER THE PLACEMENT LINES WITH THE TWO PIECES OF FABRIC PLACED RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINES.





GENTLY PEEL UP THE FABRIC FROM THE STABILIZER ON THE TACK DOWN LINES.



THE FABRIC SHOULD BE COMPLETELY REMOVED AS SHOWN HERE.



PLACE PIECES OF TAPE OVER THE EAR PLACEMENT LINES ON THE STABILIZER WHERE YOU REMOVED THE FABRIC.

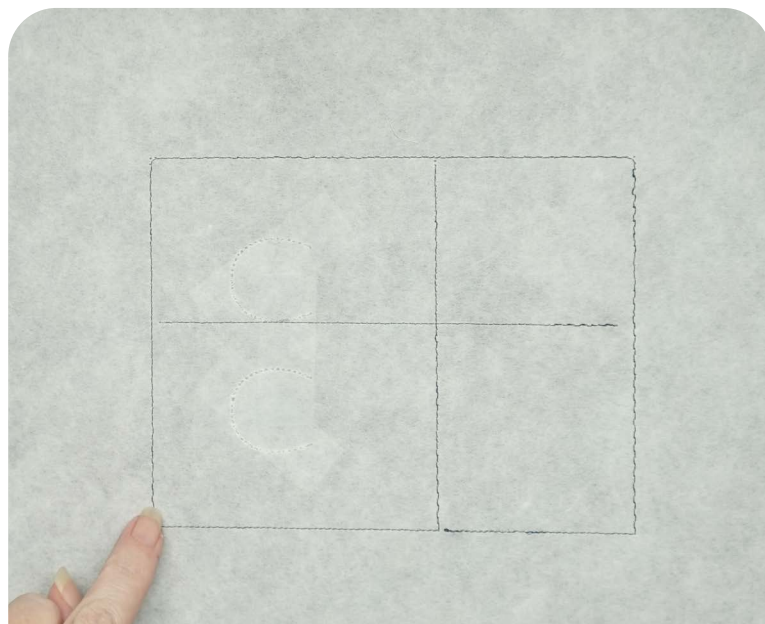


TRIM AROUND EACH EAR WITH PINKING SHEARS





TURN THE EARS RIGHT SIDE OUT AND IRON THEM



STITCH THE NEXT SET OF PLACEMENT LINES



CUT TWO PIECES OF FABRIC TO COVER THIS HALF OF THE OVERALL BOX GENEROUSLY.

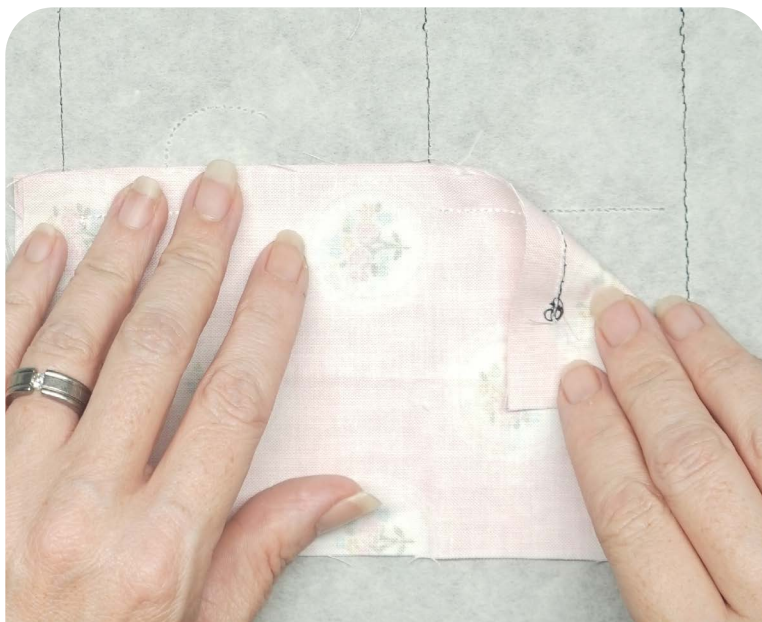


PLACE THE TWO FABRICS RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER SO THEY OVERLAP THIS LINE BY 1/2"

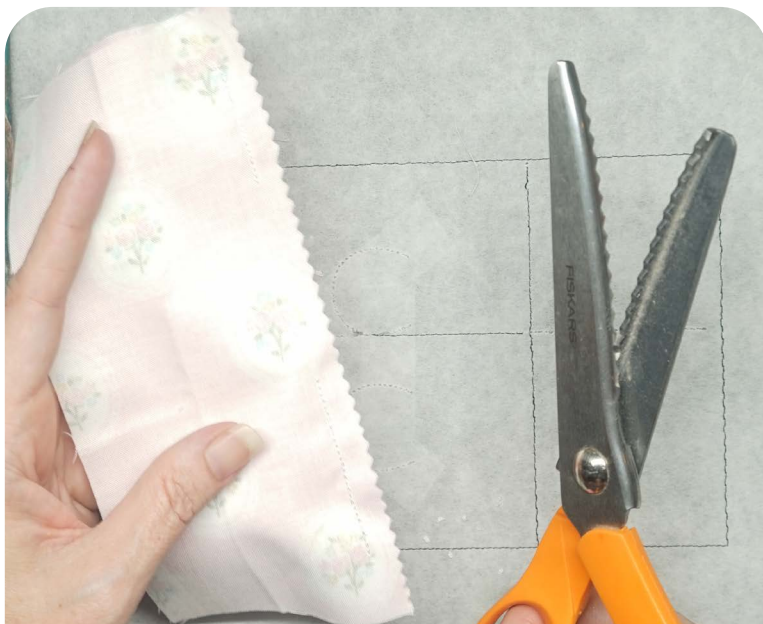




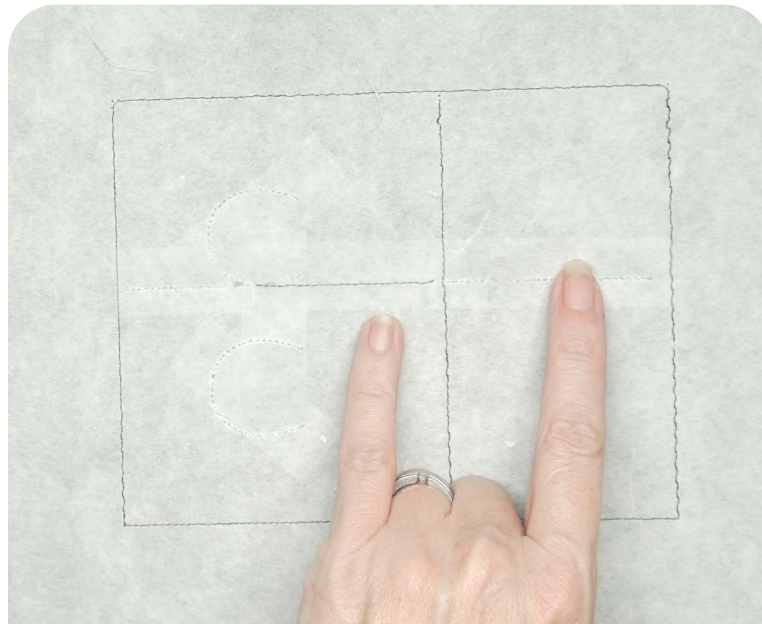
STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINES



GENTLY PEEEL UP THE FABRIC FROM THE STABILIZER ON THE STITCHED LINES. SNIP ANY THREAD WITH SCISSORS THAT PREVENTS A CLEAN REMOVAL.



TRIM THE FABRIC NEXT TO THE STITCH EDGE WITH PINKING SHEARS MAKING SURE YOU HAVE ABOUT 1/2" SEAM ALLOWANCE ON THE REMOVED FABRIC PANEL. SET ASIDE.



PLACE A PIECE OF TAPE OVER THE LINE RUNNING DOWN THE CENTER SO YOU CAN KEEP USING THE STABILIZER.

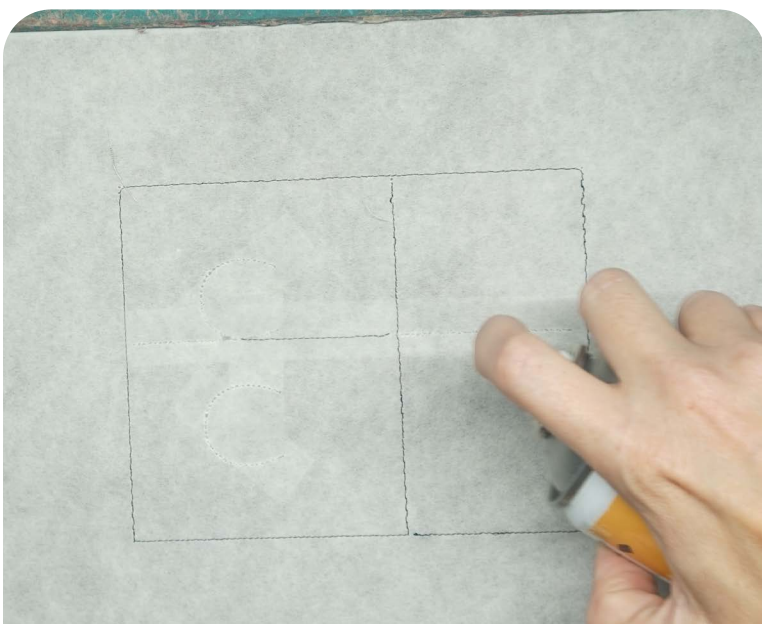




UNFOLD THE LOOSE FABRIC PANEL AND IRON IT FLAT.



CUT ONE PIECE OF FABRIC TO COVER THE BOTTOM HALF OF THE BOX GENEROUSLY.



SPRAY TEMPORARY SPRAY ADHESIVE ON THE STABILIZER ON THE LOWER HALF OF THE BOX.

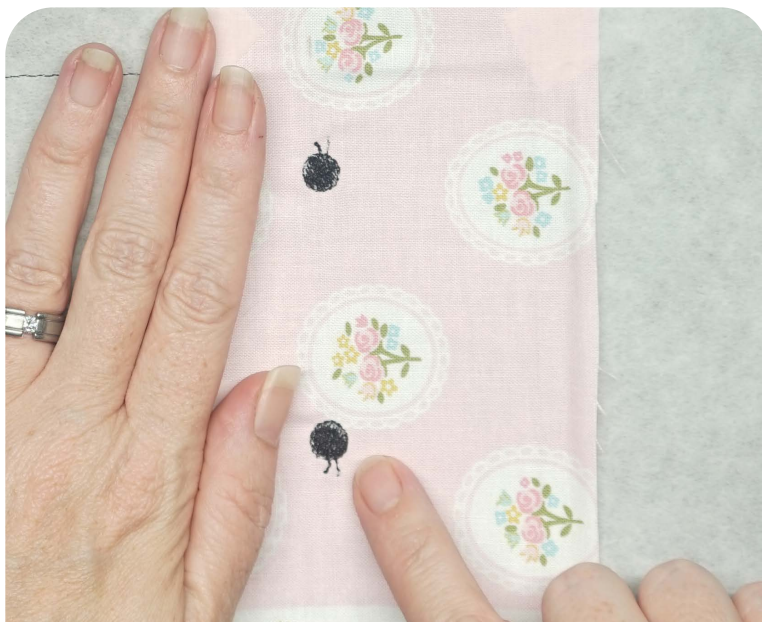


PLACE THE FABRIC RIGHT SIDE UP SO IT OVERLAPS THIS LINE BY 1/2"





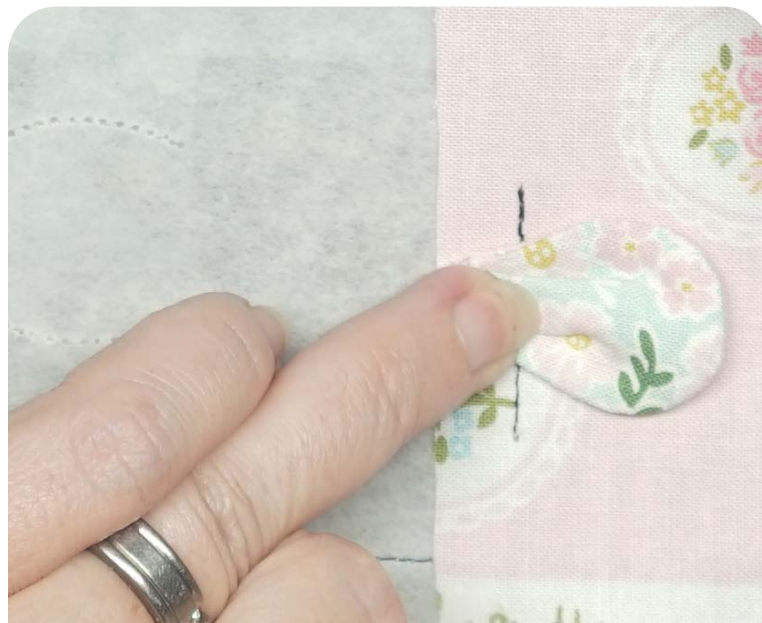
STITCH THEE PLACEMENT LINE FOR THE EARS.



STITCH THE EYES



STITCH THE WHISKARS



PLACE AN EAR OVER EACH EAR PLACEMENT LINE. YOU CAN FOLD THEM A LITTLE AS I HAVE DONE HERE.





TAPE THE EARS IN PLACE AND THEN STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINE FOR EACH OF THE EARS



CUT ONE PIECE OF FABRIC TO GENEROUSLY COVER THE UPPER HALF OF THE BOX.



PLACE THIS PIECE OF FABRIC RIGHT SIDE DOWN ON TOP OF THE OTHER FABRIC AND EARS AS SHOWN.



STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINE





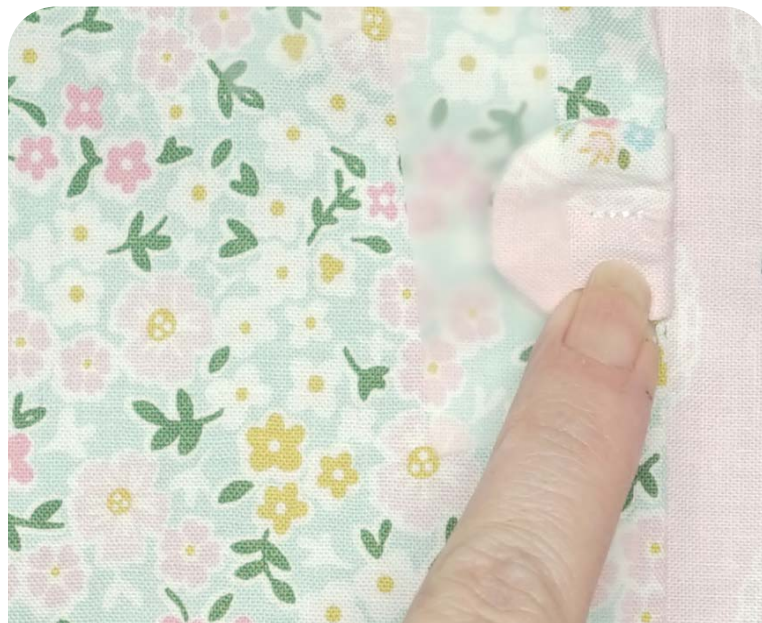
TRIM THE EXCESS FABRIC ALONG THE TACK DOWN LINE SO YOU HAVE ABOUT 1/2" LEFT



UNFOLD THE TOP MOST LAYER OF FABRIC AND SMOOTH IT FLAT. YOU CAN TAPE IT OR USE TEMPORARY SPRAY ADHESIVE ON THE STABILIZER TO KEEP IT LAYING FLAT.



FOLD BOTH EARS TO THIS SIDE AND TAPE THEM IN PLACE. IF THE FABRIC UNDERNEATH MOVES, USE THE TEMPORARY SPRAY ADHESIVE TO SECURE IT TO THE STABILIZER.



STITCH THE TACK DOWN LINES TO SECURE THE EARS.





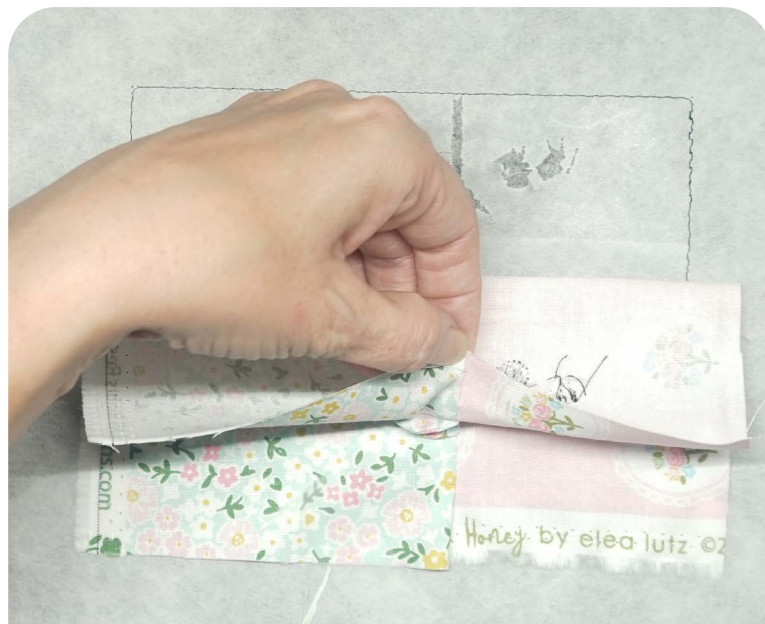
STITCH THE CENTER LINE.



NOW GENTLY UNFOLD THE FABRIC ON THIS SIDE OF THE NEW STITCH LINE. LOOSEN THE EYE, THE WHISKARS FROM THE STABILIZER TO FREE IT

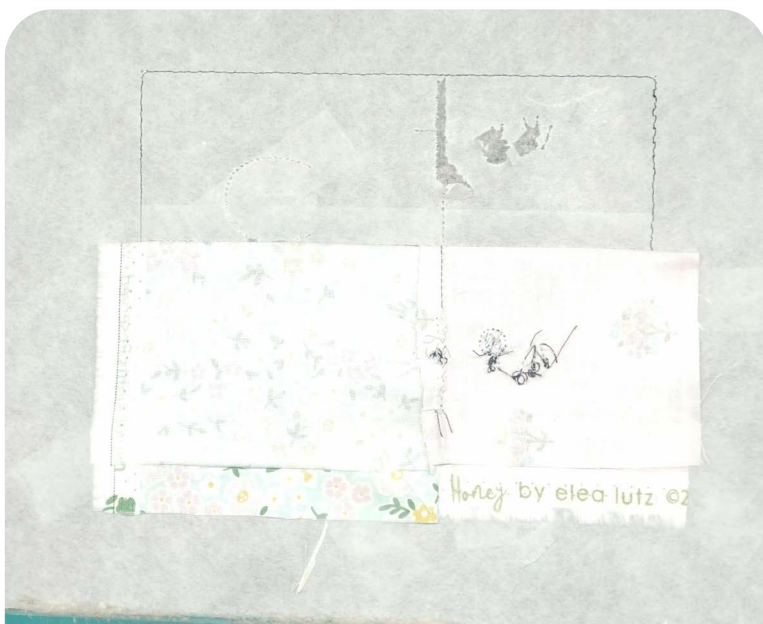


YOU WILL ALSO BE PEEING IT UP ON THE STITCH LINE. JUST GO SLOW AND GENTLY PEEE IT UP. MAKE SURE YOU PEEE UP THE FABRIC ALL THE WAY TO THE CENTER LINE



FOLD THE LOOSE HALF OF THE FABRIC OVER ON TOP OF THE OTHER SIDE. THE EYES, WHISKARS AND EARS SHOULD ALL ALIGN.





ONCE ALIGNED TAPE THE LOOSE FABRIC IN PLACE VERY WELL



STITCH THE CURVED TACK DOWN LINE. ITS HARD TO SEE IN THIS PICTURE BECAUSE I USED WHITE THREAD.



TRIM THE EXCESS FABRIC ALONG THE NEW CURVED STITCH LINE. YOU WILL HAVE TO SNIP SOME CENTER LINE THREADS TO DO SO.



NOW UNFOLD THE TOP LAYER OUTWARD BY GRABBING THE CORNERS AS SHOWN.





TAPE THE FABRIC IN PLACE



STITCH THE BOX AT THE TOP HERE AND AN ALL OVER TACK DOWN LINE



ALSO A TRIANGLE FOR ALIGNMENT WILL STITCH



CUT THREE PIECES OF YARN OR A PIECE OF RIBBON FOR THE TAIL





FOLD UP THE RIBBON OR YARN AS SHOWN. TAPE IT IN PLACE AT THE CENTER OF THE BODY SO ITS OUT OF THE WAY BUT THE ENDS ARE OVER THE BOX AT THE TOP. STITCH THE TACK DOWN FOR THE TAIL.



NOW WE NEED THE BACK PANEL



ALIGN THE SEAM ON THE BACK PIECE WITH THE TRIANGLE AT THE NOSE



ALIGN THE TOP BLACK BOX (THERE IS A CENTER LINE) WITH THE SEAM ON THE BACK PIECE





TAPE IN PLACE



STITCH THE FINAL TACK DOWN LINE.



REMOVE FROM THE STABILIZER.



TRIM CLOSE TO THE FINAL TACK DOWN LINE WITH PINKING SHEARS. TRY NOT TO CUT THE LOOP OF YARN AS THIS HELPS IT STAY BETTER





TURN THE MOUSE RIGHT SIDE OUT.



OPTIONAL: YOU CAN ADD A NOSE TO YOUR MOUSE WITH A BLACK PLASTIC SAFETY EYE. ITS JUST AS CUTE WITHOUT IT.



MAKE A VERY TINY SLIT JUST BIG ENOUGH FOR THE STUD ON THE SAFETY EYE AT THE TIP OF THE FACE. DO NOT MAKE IT TOO BIG OR YOUR FABRIC WILL FRAY.



PUSH THE SAFETY EYE INTO THE HOLE YOU MADE.





REACH INSIDE AND PLACE THE LOCKING PLASTIC DISC ONTO THE STUD



STUFF THE MOUSE WITH POLYFIL VERY WELL



ONCE ITS ALL STUFFED, DONT FORGET TO BRAID THE YARN AND KNOT IT TO COMPLETE THE TAIL



THE MINI MOUSE ALL COMPLETED MAKES A FANTASTIC PIN CUSHION FOR YOUR SEWING ROOM OR A TOY FOR A PET
